



Application to Appear and Sell Books at the SSA Booth
Tucson Festival of Books
University of Arizona: March 14 and 15, 2009

The Society of Southwestern Authors has reserved a 10x10 booth at the Tucson Festival of Books. Members who would like to be present to sell books in person should contact Sam Turner (clearskys@Cox.net) or Ashleen O’Gaea (O.Gaea_Writes@Comcast.net) and complete this application no later than February 15, 2009, to be included on the schedule.

As many as four authors will be able to share the booth in each one-hour time slot. Each author may bring up to three titles to sell, and may have a sign up to 11” x 14”. Each author will be responsible for his/her own inventory, receipts, and change-making. No books will be sold for authors who do not attend in person.

Tables and chairs will be provided.

We ask that in-person sellers make a contribution of \$5 to help defray the booth cost; those who volunteer to staff the booth during another time segment don’t need to pay. Details, such as the exact location of our booth – will be posted on the List Serve and on line as they become available; authors who provide an e-mail address or phone number will be notified in person.
